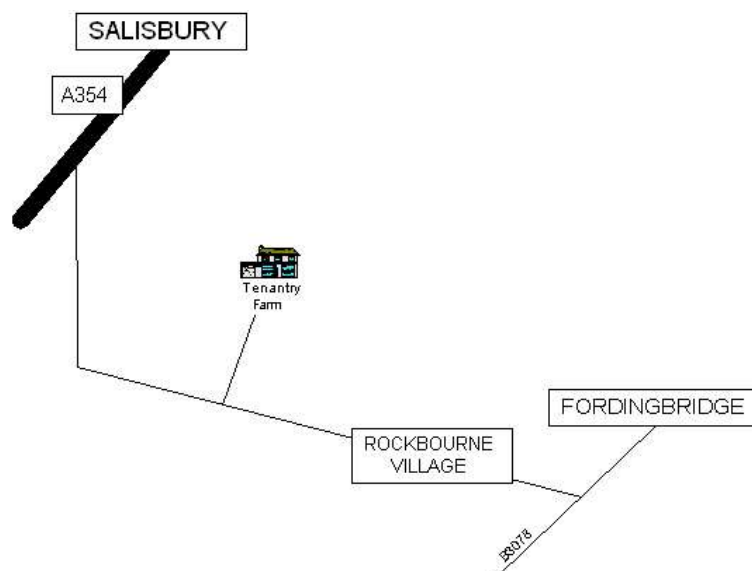

BHS HANTS - RULES AND CONDITIONS – CARRIAGE DRIVERS

Sunday 29th September 2019 from 2pm

1. **All Participants must provide evidence of valid public liability insurance**
2. All horses, ponies & donkeys must be at least 4 years old.
3. Carriages must not carry more passengers than designed for – welfare of the horse is paramount (NOTE: minimum of driver & capable groom required)
4. Junior Drivers must be at least 10yrs old with a competent adult seated next to them. Grooms must be at least 12 yrs. old if the driver is over 18yrs old. For drivers under 18yrs old, grooms must be over 18yrs old.
5. Hard hats conforming to the current standards to be worn by **all** participants when mounted on horse or carriage.
6. Participants should satisfy themselves that the condition of their vehicle, harness and equipment is adequate to meet the needs of the event. A spares kit and basic first aid kit should be carried.
7. Although dogs are welcome, they must be on a lead at all times, except Carriage Dogs with bronze or higher awards
8. Instructions from course stewards must be obeyed.
9. The organisers accept no liability for any loss, injury or damage to any equine, person, or their property and equipment, however caused.
10. If for any reason the event cannot take place a sum of £2.00 per participant will be retained by the organisers to cover expenses including first aid.
11. In the event of cancellation or postponement, participants must contact the Secretary to claim any refund within 14 days of the original event date (by 13 Oct 2019).
12. Refunds (less £2 admin fee) will be given on receipt of Doctors or Vet Certificate received within 2 weeks of event (by 13 Oct 2019).
13. Participants can be exchanged at no extra charge (with correctly signed form)
14. All those entering this event will be deemed to have accepted the above conditions.
